Dear High School Band/Orchestra Teacher or Music Instructor:

The Washtenaw Community Concert Band (WCCB) proudly announces its fourth annual Concerto Competition. The prize for the winner will be an opportunity to **perform with the WCCB in the spring of 2018 and a check for \$1,500. The runner-up will will receive a check for \$500 and perform with the WCCB at a 2018 summer concert.**

Applicants must be enrolled in **grades 9–12 at a public, parochial, or private high school in Washtenaw County**, be a member of the school's **band or orchestra**, and play a **wind or percussion instrument** commonly used in concert bands. Music to be performed for the audition must be from an **approved list of concertos** for soloist and wind band.


Applications are due **Friday, January 5, 2018**. Application materials, rules and procedures, the approved music list, and additional posters are available at **WCCBand.org/concerto**.
